3. CHECK DISK SPACE USAGE & BACK-UP DRIVES

We recommend having at least 15% of your server drive available.

5. CHECK DISK SPACE & LOG FILES

If disk space is getting low, clean up log files. Look into the date created and consider if you're using them. The more problems your system has, the bigger these files get.

4. CHECK YOUR USERS & LICENSES

Know how many users are accessing the system and compare that to your license agreement so you don't get caught up in a compliance suit with the software manufacturer.
